- Print tooth mat for each student/ player
- 2. Give each student/ player a Do A Dot marker or highlighter
- 3. Print, cut out and laminate the high frequency words (teeth)
- 4. Take turns drawing a tooth and reading the word. If the word is read correctly student/ player highlights the word on the tooth mat and returns the tooth card to the pile.
- 5. If word is read incorrectly tooth card is returned to the pile and student/ player does not get to highlight the word on their tooth mat.
- 6. Brush, Brush cards can be used in several ways
 - 1. They can end the game and player with most highlighted words wins
 - 2. Can be used to have everyone stand up and sing a song, or chant about brushing (ours is "Brusha, Brusha, Brusha, Brush your teeth, Brush your teeth, Brush them nice and clean."
 - If students/ players do not put tooth cards back into the pile after they are drawn then a
 Brush, Brush card can mean they put all the tooth cards back (this gives others the chance to
 draw those cards and complete their mats.
